EQUITY - The wage disparity for women in similar jobs to men is 79 cents on the dollar in the general work force. That disparity is narrowed to 92.5 cents in construction. This large span could have a huge impact on a woman's lifetime earning potential. Women overall lose out on more than \$400,000 over the course of their careers, but women of color are shorted more than double that. When compared to the earnings of white men, that wage loss figure rises to \$883,040 for Native American women, \$877,480 for black women and \$1,007,080 for Latinas.

OPPORTUNITY FOR ALL GIRLS - Currently, the construction work force is only 8% women. Construction and transportation have a wide bridge of entry into careers – from a 4 year college degree to high school graduates, there is a place in construction for young women. Many programs focus on possibilities but few take that final path to the realities of jobs. Due to the acute need for workers in construction, we can make that complete career pathway a reality.

SELF ESTEEM - Transportation and Construction Girl targets girls from 13 – 20 years old. At this age, girls are determining what is possible in their lives. When girls enter high school, their self esteem goes down by 30%. Without role models and examples, options are limited to a girl's economic realm of experience. Awareness and interactive opportunities help this small view of possibilities expand to hundreds of options. Young women deserve career choices.
