Citizens' Academy began in 2007 as a program of Transit Alliance, a nonprofit which empowered residents to transform mobility in Colorado. The academy's almost 900 engaged and informed graduates have been instrumental in shaping Colorado's future. When the Transit Alliance closed in 2018, the Denver Regional Council of Governments assumed responsibility for Citizens' Academy.
